FEAST OF ST TERESA OF ÁVILA | Saturday 15 October

St Teresa was born March 28 1515 in Ávila, Spain and died October 4 1582 in Alba de Tormes. She was canonized 1622; feast day October 15). A nun and one of the great mystics and religious women of the Roman Catholic church, author of spiritual classics such as her autobiographical *Life of the Mother Teresa of Jesus*. She was the originator of the Carmelite Reform, which restored and emphasized the austerity and contemplative character of primitive Carmelite life.

St Teresa was elevated to doctor of the church in 1970 by Pope Paul VI, the first woman to be so honoured.

'Whenever we think of Christ, we should recall the love that led Him to bestow on us so many graces and favors, and also the great love God showed in giving us in Christ a pledge of His love; for love calls for love in return.'
