The Procession from the Hall to Church starts at 10.25 am.

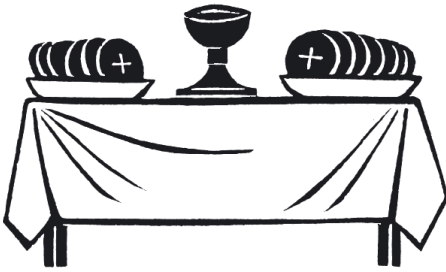
● After the 12 Noon Mass at St Bernadette's we will welcome members of High Carntyne Church to receive from them the Cross which will be returned on Good Friday.
