THIS WEEK'S NOTICES

Today is the solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Feast of the Body & Blood of Our Lord, a feast to encourage devotion to Christ in his sacrament of love.

Jesus promised to be with us to the end of time. There are three ways we encounter Jesus: in the Sacrament of Holy Communion, in the Church (i.e. us) and one day in his risen Body. Do I truly believe Jesus is in the tabernacle? This feast unites us to last week's feast of the Holy Trinity, the Father's love for the Son and how Jesus nourishes us and feeds us.

Today is also Father's Day, where we pray for all Dads and Fathers. Spend time with your children. You are your child's hero. Do you know that? The image of God the Father is reflected in the image and work of Dads and Fathers. Fatherhood is a great vocation and is linked in the heart of Christ with Christian Marriage. It is unfortunate that many couple fail to realise this and become fearful of Marriage. A reminder that it is incumbent on Catholics to be married before their Priest with two witnesses (see Canon Law and the Catechism of the Catholic Church).

We wish all Fathers a holy day.

Our Bidding Prayers are given for the concern of the Church and the World. We have prayed each day for those affected by the terrible fire in London. It is the world we live in that as we concentrate on one disaster we quickly forget others i.e. the Manchester Concert disaster, the events at London Bridge. This is often driven by the media politicizing tragedies and criticising others. In this world where everyone has something to say, it is important not to become overwhelmed by the powerful media at work in the world today, including the powerful companies who control modern communication.
